

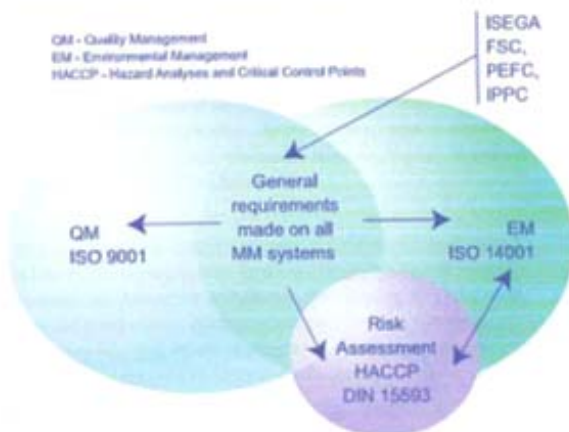
Hygiene and Environment

B&B's Quality Management system



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On 30 May 2007, the Brigl & Bergmeister plants in Austria and Slovenia were both successfully certified to ISO 9001 for Quality Management, and awarded the ISO 14001 ECO Environment Certificate and the HACCP Hygiene Certificate.



What assurance does this provide?

HACCP stands for Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points, which means analyzing hazardous materials and monitoring critical points. It is a method for identifying potential hazards for food products (including packaging) in the manufacturing process.

ECO is the internal abbreviation for environmental certification that ensures risk minimization for the company, and compliance with environmental legislation.

The hygiene standard is important for packaging paper in close proximity to food, and must be verifiable. B&B is one of the very few manufacturers in the paper packaging industry that already have this high standard.

For B&B's customers in the food and drink industries, this means:

- Improves the company's environmental credentials
- B&B provides transparency to third parties
- Access to new markets in the food & drink industries
- Ensures compliance with legal requirements

B&B manufactures label papers and flexible packaging papers at locations in Austria and Slovenia, and organizes the Label Conference and the Golden Label Award.
